

Utility Buckets

Utility Bucket - "Slip on the forks" accessory buckets or also known as Universal Fit buckets could be used along with any model or design of extendable reach forklift. If your unit is unable to be matched with a quick-tach component, another brand new or used universal fit bucket can be located as an alternative. Regular universal lift truck buckets attach to blades that are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Larger fork pockets can be ordered through an account manager upon request.

Since they slip directly onto the blades, universal fit buckets stay on the machinery and are a lot less susceptible to damage. Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are fifty percent. This additional space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for example moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are constructed for extendable-reach forklifts. They are designed to allow positioning of material far beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on the leading edge and on both sides reinforces stability, resistance to damage and provides supreme durability. Quick-Tach forklift buckets are augmented by scuff bars along the bottom of the unit which protect it from scrapes.

Quick-Tach lift truck buckets can be used to substitute the carriage and blades that weigh between 100-700lbs. Once installed, these buckets free up more of the unit's cargo capacity, enabling it to handle heavier and larger objects. The Quick-Tach is able to dump materials more or less 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are designed in a customized fashion to be able to meet the specs of specific makes and models of forklifts.
